Highways Report

a) Accidents- No new accidents were reported by members present this month. b) Hedges and clearance of debris- work on the footpath in the High Street has now been completed. Clerk to thank TH for his help. JT

c) Church Lane Potholes-Whilst some patching of the numerous pot holes has been carried out, one very large one has been missed. JR advised he had contacted Trevor Ward who said that the issue was being taken up by his boss Derek Jerrard. JR has contacted Derek and is awaiting a reply JR

d) Local Plan meeting at Stevenage- JR, CP and HN attended a meeting with Richard Javes, Planning Policy Manager and Caroline Danby Principle Planning Officer at SBC's Council Offices on 26/10/15. The purpose of the meeting, at SBC's invitation, was to discuss where SBC was with their Local Plan and their views on the future development of Stevenage Town Centre. As their Local Plan had yet to be approved Richard was only able to discuss their proposals in general terms but we will be meeting again in early December once the Plan is approved. Redevelopment of office buildings in the town centre and the Matalan site currently being undertaken/recently approved will provide some 2,500 homes. It was interesting to note that Richard stated that SBC's plans for development North of Stevenage was on a standalone basis and did not require the development proposed by NHDC South of Graveley to make the project viable.

e) Retaining Wall 2 and 4 High Street- JR has spoken to Trevor Ward who advised it has been agreed that the wall needs some remedial work. JR to find out when this work will be carried out. JR

f) Graveley Neighbourhood Plan- JR to speak to Stuart Izzard to find out what is required to put

such a plan in place and what benefits might accrue to the village.. \mathbf{JR}

d) Inconsiderate Parking-a member of the public raised the issue of parking by cars and vans on the junction of Ashwell Close/Common which caused drivers coming up from Ashwell Close to have a limited view of oncoming traffic which could make an accident very likely. Photographs of the problems were viewed and it was agreed that the Clerk send these together with a letter requesting action to Herts Homes who replied saying it was a Police problem. Our local PCSO Michelle Trussell replied and said she would keep an eye on the problem and take action if necessary. Clerk also sent details to TH who replied *Happy to add to my highways locality budget list for next year.* Clerk to ask GM to put in the PCSO's contact details. **JT**
