a) 1a High Street- 17/00792/1EUD | Certificate of Lawful Development: Continued existing use as B8 (storage and distribution). **This Application was withdrawn**

b) 1a High Street- Outline Application: Erection of 3 x 3 bed detached dwellings and 4 x 2 bed semi-detached dwellings (all matters reserved except access). - Case Ref No: 17/01132/1- This application was discussed- two Council members were against, one abstained and two were in favour- JR as Chairman had the casting vote and it was agreed that GPC would not oppose the application.

In the discussions it was pointed out-

a.) The area of the proposed development is within the green belt, as such the area is not a brownfield site.

b.) There is not any evidence that the site is previously developed land. The GPC has concerns

regarding the access and egress from the site onto a busy road that has a history of numerous accidents.

Clerk to send to NHDC our comments. Also at the meeting was a Planning Consultant Gay Parry who was representing the applicant, her views were noted. **JT** (Done 21/06/17)

c) Proposed development of a 50 Mgwt Gas Fired Power Station at Little Wymondley, closing date 26/6/2017. This was discussed but it was felt that GPC should take no action.
