23/087	<p>Reports from County & District Councillors, Police and others</p> <p>Cllr Griffiths read out an email received regarding NHC election uncontested fee proposals, effective from May 2024. Cllr Griffiths would be representing the GPC on any comments. The GPC had already been made aware of this proposal (GPC due to respond to the Clerk by 2nd November 2023). Councillors of GPC commented that overall they did not have an objection and found it to be fair that it was tiered charging.</p> <p>Cllr Jarvis spoke about the 20mph proposal that will include Graveley. It will include Grinders End and he suggested that the scheme could go further up Church Lane. The footpath at Graveley Lane and Milksey Lane is due to be resurfaced in December 2023.</p>
23/088	<p>Finance</p> <p>To authorise payments made in accordance with the budget.</p> <p>a) To authorise the payment schedule for October 2023.</p> <p>Resolved. Proposed by Cllr Griffin. Seconded by Cllr Atkinson. October 2023 payment schedule was authorised. Unanimously approved.</p> <p>b) To consider and agree draft budget proposal for financial year 2024/25.</p> <p>The Clerk explained that she had reviewed expenditure and the potential increases, but she was trying to keep the budget in line with previous years due to the cost of living crisis. She stated that although there might be some unexpected increases/changes, there was some money in reserve that could help should this arise.</p> <p>Resolved. Proposed by Cllr Griffin. Seconded by Cllr Lumley. It was agreed that the draft budget be the final one to be used for the financial year 2024/2025. Unanimously approved.</p> <p>Cllr Griffin extended his thanks on behalf of GPC to the Clerk for the work involved in preparing the 2024/2025 budget.</p>

23/090	<p>Clerks report</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Redecorating/Maintenance of the two benches at Pondside are complete and the Clerk will receive quotes in spring 2024 for the other work to be completed on the benches. • HCC have been chased again regarding the Graveley Footpath 017, Graveley. The hedge between the two pubs. The Clerk has asked again for HCC to either maintain the hedge or ask the farmer to do so as it is overgrown. • NHC Planning office have declined to attend the invitation to a Parish Council meeting, but are available for any one that would like to discuss planning matters over the telephone. • The new lawnmower has been delivered and the leaf blower is due to be collected this week for a service. • The proposal for notice of Polling Districts and Polling places review has been added to the Graveley Parish web site for residents to read and comment via the NHC. • It has been reported that the litter bin by the bench at the Waggon and Horses smelt foul as it is a litter/dog litter waste bin. The Clerk has spoken to the NHC about moving this bin and has revisited her suggestion to move the bin up by 2 & 4 High Street, as there is an increase in the number of cars parking in that locality. The nearest litter bin to this location is High Street near the layby, adjacent to the cricket pitch. She has requested that it be moved to near the entrance of that area/near the footpath so that it is easily visible and allow refuse collection lorries to access it without difficulty. There are still two other bins by the Waggon & Horses. NHC have agreed to move it and at no cost to the Parish Council.
